UNITED STATES' MOTION TO DISMISS PLAINTIFF'S AMENDED COMPLAINT

COMES NOW the United States of America, on behalf of the United States

Department of Health and Human Services ("HHS"), Kathleen Sebelius, in her official
capacity as Secretary of HHS, and Margaret Hamburg, in her official capacity as

Commissioner of Food and Drugs, United States Food and Drug Administration ("FDA")
(collectively, "Defendants"), pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1) and
12(b)(6) and Local Rule 7, moves for dismissal of Plaintiffs' Amended Complaint as
follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(1), this Court lacks subject matter jurisdiction over this action because plaintiffs do not have standing and their claims are not ripe for review.
- Declaratory and injunctive relief barring the government from applying
 FDA's regulations to them is foreclosed by the Supreme Court's holding in *Ewing v*.

Mytinger & Casselberry, Inc., 339 U.S. 594 (1950).

3. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6), as a matter of law, plaintiffs have failed to state a claim upon which relief can be granted, both because they have failed to exhaust their administrative remedies and because their substantive arguments are without merit.

WHEREFORE, the United States respectfully requests that the Court grant its

Motion to Dismiss Plaintiffs' Amended Complaint, and that this Court grant such further
relief as it deems proper under the circumstances.
